

CubJAM – 3rd May 2026 - All leaders meeting

My NAN assessor has asked if you have any risk assessments too that can be shared and any contingency plans? Thanks

Yes there will be a full set of Risk Assessments compiled for the main camp, to cover the camp, including the activities, the build, car parking & access, etc.

The CubJAM risk assessments will be approved by the approving Lead Volunteer as part of the main camp NAN.

Normally the assessor will see your camp risk assessments

In the event of something serious such as bad weather we will communicate with all leaders. We also have contingency plans for arrival and departure car parking off site if needed.

Looking at the Map, do all young leaders need to camp on the YL camp?

Not if they are part of your camping group, this is an area for young leaders who are staff

is the car park secure to leave trailers there?

Sorry wrong chat - yes, the car park is behind hedgerows and fences the gates will be manned and people on site from Wednesday, we would still recommend locking your travels as you would do normally and we cannot be responsible for vehicles and trailers left onsite, neither can Rutland Showground

Lanyards on the Thurs night?

You do not need to wear lanyards on Thursday night you can collect on Friday

Should we have ordered lanyards? Or will the pack be made up based upon our booking forms?

The leader's packs will contain lanyards for everyone, please return these. On Sunday Collect up all lanyard and return them to the Sub Camp Leader (the ID badges can be kept).

Can Leaders collect Lanyards and passes on Thursday night?

You should be available to collect on Thursday evening

Who has radios? And if we have some, should we bring our own?

Many of the key staff and activity staff will have camp radios on a secure network, if you want to you can, but not essential.

Would you advise taking a portable loo for night time use?

There are 18 Portaloo's in the middle of the Sub Camp areas and 6 in the activity area between Sub Camp areas and the big top, that's 24 in total. They will have night lights in them, and we will service them during the camp, so there is good coverage. There is no emptying point for night loos on the showground site, so you will need to take them with you.

Will the t-shirts be available to buy if we haven't pre - bought them?

I will double check this answer - There maybe a few, but these will be 1 or 2, certainly not many, we would advise you do not wait to the camp.

Do I need to put my day visiting leaders on my NAN?

Yes please.

Can we get replacement Lanyards

Yes, Sub Camp Leaders or the camp office will have spares if they get damaged.

Do any kids who want to go to bed earlier, have that option? i.e. miss the evening events and go to bed @ 8:30 or 9pm?

Yes, there are no rules from us, we are providing the programme elements you are responsible for the Cubs, you decide what works best for your cubs

Will we have a pickup slot like we do for arrivals?

For departures no, we will provide extra car parking capacity for departures. Please do still car share for the departures.

I think you can buy an adult Necker for the event. How about Neckers for Cubs?

Cubs need to wear their own group Neckers during the camp

Will there be a similar briefing for staff volunteers?

We will do a video briefing with slides for staff.

When do we receive the chants etc from sub camps? And will we be setting up a WhatsApp group like last time?
